LEAGUE OF WOMEN VOTERS OF MASSACHUSETTS
HOSTS FORUM ON TRANSPORTATION ISSUES

BOSTON- A panel of specialists will address transportation concerns throughout the state at a League of Women Voters' forum on transportation issues Wednesday, April 28.

Representative Carl M. Sciortino, Jr., Vice-Chair of the Joint Committee on Transportation; Stephanie Pollack, Associate Director, Dukakis Center for Urban and Regional Policy at Northeastern University; and Rachel Kaprielian, Registrar, Massachusetts Registry of Motor Vehicles will participate in a panel discussion on transportation issues, moderated by Anne Paulsen, former State Representative for the 24th Middlesex District.

The forum, "Getting Around in Massachusetts," will be in the Gardner Auditorium at the State House, beginning at 9:30 a.m.

The panel will discuss the reorganization of the Massachusetts Department of Transportation, and the financing, environmental impact and balance of public and private options in all areas of transportation.

The panel is part of the League's annual Day on the Hill event, which is expected to attract over 100 League members from across the state.

The state League, celebrating its 90th anniversary this year, is conducting a two-year study of transportation concerns to update its position on the issue developed in 1973.

Following the transportation program, League legislative specialists will outline current legislative initiatives the LWVMA is supporting or opposing in the legislative session.

League members from around the state will discuss the League legislative priorities with their individual Senators and Representatives after the morning program.
